LEARNING ACTIVITIES SUCCESS CRITERIA

I can make an information leaflet describing what a croft is. Find information on the Crofting Commission website, including:

- What is a croft?
- The normal size of a croft.
- The three duties that crofters must comply with.
- The areas of Scotland where crofts are.
- The number of crofts and crofters in Scotland.
- Common grazings.

I can contribute to a display/exhibition/open day on crofting in my local area:

- Visit a local croft.
- Invite a crofter in to school to speak to pupils.
- Find out which animals are kept by crofters in your area - eg sheep, cattle, pigs, hens, etc - and why they keep these animals.
- Choose one type of animal kept by crofters and find out about their upkeep throughout the year.
- Find out what happens to the crofter's animals and how they enter the food chain.
- Make a list of Gaelic words associated with crofting.
- Cook a dish with some meat from a croft.
- Find out which crops are grown by crofters locally.
- Grow a crop in school (eg potatoes) to see what is involved.
- Cook a dish with locally grown vegetables.
- Visit the common grazings and find out how it is organised and run.
- Attend a meeting of the grazings committee, or invite the grazings clerk into school to answer questions.
- Make a map of the local crofts.

Do you think the three duties that a crofter must comply with are reasonable?

Why do you think crofts are usually so small?

What is the difference between a croft and a farm?

How could crofting be improved?

Would you like to a crofter? Why? Why not?

Do you think crofting will still be around in fifty year's time?
